A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF YEARS A PERSON MAY SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A NONPROFIT CORPORATION ENGAGED IN THE PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Nonprofit health care corporations -- limit on term of director. No person may serve more than 9 years as a member of the board of directors of a nonprofit private corporation primarily engaged in the provision of health care.
