The department 11 shall: (1) study conditions affecting the citizens of the 12 13 state by making use of birth, death, and sickness records; 14 (2) make investigations, disseminate information, and 15 make recommendations for control of diseases and improvement 16 of public health to persons, groups, or the public;

(3) at the request of the governor, administer any 17 federal health program for which responsibilities are 18 delegated to states; 19

20 (4) inspect and work in conjunction with custodial Z1 institutions and Nontana university system units 22 periodically as necessary and at other times on request of **Z**3 the governor;
