BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Curriculum to include health hazards of marijuana. (1) Every public elementary and high school in the state of Montana shall include in its curriculum a course on the health hazards of marijuana (Cannabis sativa). The content of the course shall:

- (a) be limited to the harmful physiological and psychological effects of the drug; and
- (b) be reviewed and approved by the board of trustees of each district before being offered for study.
- (2) The provisions of this section do not prevent instruction as to the harmful physiological or psychological effects of other dangerous drugs.
