FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request received <u>March 15</u>, 19, 79, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>Senate Bill 181</u> pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION:

This proposed bill amends section 15-70-322, MCA, to provide that the United States and the State are exempt from the payments of tax on special fuel.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The tax on use of special fuels has never been levied against the United States Government.
- 2. The tax on use of special fuels levied against the State of Montana amounted to approximately \$1,450 in FY78.
- 3. The revenues paid by the State of Montana for the tax on special fuels will amount to approximately \$1,500 for FY80 and FY81.

EFFECT ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT:

Revenues to local governments for street and road purposes will be decreased by a certain percentage of \$1,500 for each fiscal year.
