A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT REFUNDS OF REVENUE RECEIVED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT ARE NOT CHARGED AGAINST A SCHOOL DISTRICT'S SPENDING AUTHORITY; AMENDING SECTION 20-9-224, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-9-224, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-9-224. Credit of refund ~~is~~ refund of revenue not charged against spending authority. (1) Whenever a school district deposits with the county treasurer a refund or rebate, the county treasurer shall credit the budgeted fund to which it is deposited and restore the school district's spending authority in that fund in the amount of the refund or rebate.

(2) A refund of revenue previously received by a school district shall not be charged against a school district's spending authority."
