BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-25-312, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-25-312. Motor vehicle regulation -- enforcement of regulations -- appeals. (1) The regents may authorize the president of each unit to:

- (a) assess fees not to exceed \$10 per quarter for parking on campus;
- (b) assess fines in accordance with a published schedule for violations of motor vehicle or parking regulations of each unit in an amount not to exceed ~~\$1~~ \$10 per offense; ~~the use of parking meters shall not be authorized unless installed prior to June 1, 1971;~~
- (c) order the removal of vehicles parked in violation of motor vehicle regulations of each unit at the expense of the violator;
- (d) establish a system of appeals at each unit
