4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO GENERALLY REVISE THE
5	LAW RELATING TO INDIAN STUDIES INSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS;
6	AMENDING SECTIONS 20-4-211 AND 20-4-213, MCA."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9	Section 1. Section 20-4-211, MCA, is amended to read:
10	"20-4-211. Definitions. (1) As used in 20-4-211
11	through 20-4-214, "American Indian studies" means
12	instruction pertaining to the history, traditions, customs,
13	values, beliefs, ethics, and contemporary affairs of
14	American Indians, particularly Indian tribal groups in
15	Montana.
16	(2) As used in 20-4-211 through 20-4-214,
17	"instruction" means:
18	(a) a formal course <u>equivalent to 3 quarter credits</u> of
19	study offered by a unit of higher education developed with
20	the advice and assistance of Indian people;
21	(b) in-service training developed by the
22	superintendent of public instruction in cooperation with
23	educators of Indian descent and made available to school
24	districts; or
25	(c) in-service training provided by a local board of

trustees, which is developed and conducted in cooperation
with local Indian people."

Section 2. Section 20-4-213, MCA, is amended to read: #20-4-213. Qualification in Indian studies -- trustees and noncertified personnel. (1) By Except as provided in subsection (2), by July 1, 1979 1981, all district boards of ь trustees for elementary and secondary public school districts-on-or-in-public schools located in-the-vicinity-of on Indian reservations where or at which the enrollment of Indian children qualifies-the-school-for-faderal--funds--for Indian-education-programs is 25% or more of total enrollment shall employ only those certified personnel who have satisfied the requirements for instruction in American Indian studies as defined in 20-4-211. (2) (a) Such trustees shall allow certified personnel 2 school years from the date of initial acceptance of the contract of employment to satisfy those requirements. Such trustees may not deny initial employment as a teacher or administrator to a certified person for the sole reason that he has not yet satisfied those requirements provided he does so within the next 2 school years. (b) Subsection (1) does not apply with regard to certified personnel who are 67 years of age or older on July 1-1979-

5 <u>NEW_SECTION</u> Section 3. Education students to receive 6 Indian studies instruction. A student matriculating at any 7 unit of the Montana university system after July 1. 1979. 8 may not receive a degree in elementary or secondary 9 education unless he has received 3 quarter credits of 10 instruction in American Indian studies as defined in 11 20-4-211(2)(a).

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
