A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO RAISE THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR ELECTED COUNTY OFFICIALS 7% IN 1979 AND 7% IN 1980 AND TO ADD ADDITIONAL SALARY CATEGORIES BASED ON TAXABLE VALUATION; AMENDING SECTION 7-4-2503, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-4-2503, MCA, is amended to read:  
 "7-4-2503. Salaries of certain county officers. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the total salary paid to the county treasurer, county clerk and recorder, clerk of the district court, county attorney, county assessor, county superintendent of schools, and county sheriff; the county surveyor in counties where county surveyors receive salaries as provided in 7-4-2812; and the county auditor in all counties wherein such office is authorized shall be the sum of the salary shown in column A, based on population as of January 1, 1977 1972, when added to the salary shown in column B, based on taxable valuation as of January 1, 1977 1979, for the fiscal year ending in 1980 and shall be the sum of the salary shown in column C, based on population as of January 1, 1980, when added to the salary shown in column D, based on taxable valuation as of January 1, 1980, for the

1 fiscal year ending in 1981 as follows:

12 1979 and columns C and D in 1980, the sum of \$1,200. In each  
13 county with a population in excess of 30,000, the salary of  
14 the county attorney shall be \$30,000 per year.\*

## FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request received January 26, 1979, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate Bill 229 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the legislature upon request.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to increase the salaries of certain county officials and to add county assessors to the salary schedule.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

1. That county population and taxable valuation will remain static over the biennium.
2. That employers' share of payroll costs increases in direct proportion to gross salaries at 13%.
3. That only the salary of the elected officials listed in Section 7-4-2503, MCA, will be raised if the measure becomes law.

The increased cost must be funded \$55,221 in FY 80 and \$110,748 in FY 81 from the State General Fund with the remainder funded by local governments.

## OTHER COMMENTS:

Section 7-4-2503, MCA, pegs the salaries of deputies and assistants of county officials at 90% of the amount paid the respective county official. Historically, the salaries of all deputies and assistants tend to increase whenever the salaries of county officials are increased. Consequently, a 20% increase in the total personal services costs for each of the Officials' staff listed in Section 7-4-2503, MCA could have the following effect:
