Section 1. Section 75-10-541, MCA, is amended to read: 13 #75-10-541. Injunction -- action to collect civil 14 penalty. (1) The department, through the attorney general or 15 the--county--attorney--of--the-county-in-which-a-facility-is 15 focated, may sue to enjoin the operation or maintenance of a 17 13 motor vehicle wrecking facility or graveyard either" permanently or until compliance with this part, the rules of 19 20 the department, or an order issued pursuant to this part has 21 been demonstrated.

(2) The department, through the attorney general or
the-county-attorney-of-the-county-in-which-a--motor--vehicle
wrecking--facility--or--graveyard--is--located, may sue in
district court to collect a civil penalty as provided in

12	from the department. The attorney fees shall be set, by the
13	court having jurisdiction of the case, and the court may
14	direct the department to pay such fees during the
15	prosecution of the action or upon completion of the same. If

17	the amount of such penalty collected shall be paid over to
