7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

8 Section 1. Purpose and specifications. It is the
 9 purpose of this act to authorize the construction of a
 10 legislative office building south of and connected to the
 11 center core of the capitol building. Wherever reasonably
 12 possible, the exterior motif of the capitol building should
 13 be closely adhered to; the present circular access drive and
 14 parking should be preserved and if parking spaces are
 15 eliminated, equivalent parking should be provided; the
 16 facility shall provide office and work areas for legislators
 17 and staff, and shall include meeting rooms, an assembly
 18 auditorium, cafeteria, waiting and hospitality lobby,
 19 library, legislative council facilities, and other
 20 appropriate functional areas. The facility should be
 21 integrally connected to the capitol building, by means of a
 22 corridor on at least one level.

23 Section 2. Funding. Funding for the planning and
 24 construction of the legislative office wing is to be
 25 provided from the sale of bonds in the amount of \$7 million

1 to be repaid with revenue from the cigarette tax provided
 2 for in section 16-11-111.
