Wherever reasonably 11 12 possible, the exterior motif of the capitol building should be closely adhered to; the present circular access drive and 13 parking should be preserved and if parking spaces are 14 eliminated, equivalent parking should be provided; the 15 facility shall provide office and work areas for legislators 16 17 and staff, and shall include meeting rooms, an assembly 18 auditorium, cafeteria, waiting and hospitality lobby, 19 library, legislative council facilities, and other appropriate functional areas. The facility should be 20 21 integrally connected to the capitol building, by means of a 22 corridor on at least one level.
