INTRODUCED BY \_\_\_\_\_

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW LOCAL GOVERNING BODIES TO ADOPT STRICTER INSULATION CODES THAN THE STATE; AMENDING SECTIONS 50-60-205 AND 50-60-301, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 50-60-205, MCA, is amended to read:

"50-60-205. When state building code applies. If a municipality or county does not adopt a building code as provided in 50-60-301, the state building code applies within the municipal or county jurisdictional area and the state will enforce the code in these areas. The municipality or county may, however, at any time adopt stricter insulation standards than the state's insulation standards."

Section 2. Section 50-60-301, MCA, is amended to read:

"50-60-301. Municipal and county building codes authorized. (1) The local legislative body of a municipality or county may adopt a building code by ordinance to apply to the municipal or county jurisdictional area.

(2) A municipal or county building code may include only codes adopted by the department. A municipal or county governing body may, however, adopt stricter insulation standards than the state to further the purposes of
