INTRODUCED BY
A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO RAISE THE MINIMUM WAGE AND LONGEVITY PAY FOR A DULY CONFIRMED MEMBER OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT OF FIRST- AND SECOND-CLASS CITIES; AMENDING SECTION 7-32-4116, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Section 7-32-4116, MCA, is amended to read:
"7-32-4116. Minimum wage of police in first- and second-class cities. (1) ~~(a) Each Effective July 1, 1979, each~~ duly confirmed member of a police department of cities of the first and second class of Montana is entitled to a minimum wage for a daily service of 8 hours' work of at least ~~\$750-per \$825~~ a month for the first year of service and thereafter at least ~~\$750 \$825~~ a month plus 1% of the minimum base monthly salary of ~~\$750 \$825~~ for each additional year of service up to and including the 20th year of additional service.
(b) ~~Effective July 1, 1980, each duly confirmed member of a police department of cities of the first and second class is entitled to a minimum wage for a daily service of 8 hours' work of at least \$900 a month for the first year of service and thereafter at least \$900 a month plus 1% of the~~

~~minimum base monthly salary of \$900 for each additional year of service up to and including the 20th year of additional service.~~
(2) This section shall apply to and include all cities and towns not of the first class which have heretofore elected or may hereafter elect to come under the provisions of [11-1817 to 11-1830 inclusive]."

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 378 provides for the minimum salary to be paid to confirmed members of a police department in cities of the first and second class.

ASSUMPTION:


The salary negotiations will provide a 6% increase for each of the next two fiscal years.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact on the state.

LOCAL IMPACT:

None. All the first and second class cities are presently paying more than the minimum prescribed by statute and will be over the next two years.
