4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE DISTRICT 5 COURT PROGRAMS FUNDED BY THE COUNTY TO BE SUBJECT TO THE 6 COUNTY BUDGET LAW; AMENDING SECTIONS 7-6-2311, 7-6-2313, AND 7 40-3-114, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: Section 1. Section 7-6-2311, MCA, is amended to read: 10 11 "7-6-2311. Filing of estimate of revenues and expenses 12 with county clerk. (1) Before June 1 each year the county clerk and recorder shall notify in writing each county 13 14 official in charge of an office, department, service, or institution: or county-funded district court program of the 15 16 county to file with the county clerk and recorder, before 17 June 10, detailed and itemized estimates, both of the 18 probable revenues from sources other than taxation and of 19 all expenditures required by the office, department, 20 service, or institution for the next fiscal year.

(2) (a) The county commissioners shall submit to the
county clerk and recorder the estimate of expenditures for
all purposes for the board and a detailed statement showing
all new road and bridge construction to be financed from
county road and bridge funds, from any special road or

bridge fund, from any special highway fund, and from bond 1 2 issues issued or authorized for the next fiscal year. 3 together with the cost of that construction as computed by the county surveyor or, if for construction in charge of a 4 5 special engineer, then by that engineer. The county commissioners shall also submit to the county clerk and 6 7 recorder detailed estimates of all expenditures for B construction or improvement purposes proposed to be made 9 from the proceeds of bond issues not yet authorized and from the proceeds of tax levies which are required to be approved 10 11 at an election to be held.

12 (b) The county surveyor and any special engineer shall
13 prepare the estimates of cost of road and bridge
14 construction for the county commissioners. They shall also
15 submit a similar statement showing road and bridge
16 maintenance expenditures as nearly as can be estimated.

17 (c) The county treasurer shall prepare the estimates18 for interest and debt reduction.

19 (d) The county clerk and recorder shall prepare all
20 other estimates which properly fall within the duties of his
21 office.

22 (3) The estimates required in this section shall be 23 submitted on forms provided by the county clerk and recorder 24 and prescribed by the department of community affairs. The 25 forms may only be varied or departed from with permission -2- SB 3977

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and approval of that department. Each of the officials shall
 file the estimates within the time and in the manner
 provided in the form and notice.

4 (4) In the absence or disability of an official, the 5 duties required by this section or 7-6-2312 devolve upon the 6 official or employee in charge of the office, department, 7 service, or institution.<sup>m</sup>

8 Section 2. Section 7-6-2313, MCA, is amended to read: 9 "7-6-2313. Preparation of expenditure program and 10 information on sources of revenue. (1) From those estimates 11 the county clerk and recorder shall prepare a tabulation 12 showing the complete expenditure program of the county for 13 the current fiscal year and the sources of revenue by which 14 it is to be financed.

(2) The tabulation shall set forth:

15

16 (a) the estimated receipts from all sources other than
17 taxation for each office, department, service, or
18 institution, or district court program funded by the county
19 for the current fiscal year:

20 (b) the actual receipts for the last completed fiscal21 year;

(c) the surplus or unencumbered treasury balances atthe close of that last fiscal year;

24 (d) the amount necessary to be raised by taxation;

25 (e) the estimated expenditure for each office.

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1 department. service. or institution<u>a or district court</u>
2 program funded by the county for the current fiscal year;

3 (f) the actual expenditures for the last completed4 fiscal year;

5 (g) all contracts or other obligations which will
6 affect the current year revenues;

7 (h) the total amount of emergency warrants issued
8 during the preceding fiscal year, with the amount issued for
9 each emergency and the amount issued against each fund."

Section 3. Section 40-3-114. MCA, is amended to read: 10 "40-3-114. Budget. The provisions of the county budget 11 12 system, Title 7, chapter 6, part 23, shall, except as 13 provided by 40-3-125(3), be applicable to expenditures for 14 the court of conciliation+-providedy-howevery-that-the-court 15 information-required-by-7-6-2311-on-or-before-duly-1-of-each 16 17 veer."

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(2) (a) The county commissioners shall submit to the
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1 bridge fund, from any special highway fund, and from bond 2 issues issued or authorized for the next fiscal year. together with the cost of that construction as computed by 3 the county surveyor or, if for construction in charge of a 4 special engineer, then by that engineer. The county 5 6 commissioners shall also submit to the county clerk and 7 recorder detailed estimates of all expenditures for construction or improvement purposes proposed to be made 8 from the proceeds of bond issues not yet authorized and from 9 10 the proceeds of tax levies which are required to be approved 11 at an election to be held.

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
