## STATEMENT OF INTENT RE: SB 422

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A statement of intent is required for SB 422 in that it delegates rulemaking authority to the board of professional engineers and land surveyors in sections 6 and 7.

Section 6 gives the board the authority to adopt fees
not to exceed the various amounts listed. It is intended
that the fees will not exceed amounts necessary to meet
administrative costs.

11 Section 7 gives the board the authority to adopt rules 12 that define the maintenance of competency. The rules shall 13 provide that competency may be evidenced by either continued 14 active practice or other activities.

As regards the continued practice alternative the rules should prescribe the number of hours of practice required during the 2 year renewal period and should define the types of activities which constitute active practice.

19 As regards the "other activities" alternative the 20 following areas should be addressed:

wi11 fulfill 21 (a) types of activities that the but not limited to classroom 22 requirements. including 23 instruction. seminars. examinations, intrafirm or intracompany group study programs, or home study; 24

(b) standards for determining programs to be approved

for fulfillment of the requirements such as adequacy of
 facilities, qualifications of instructors, and course
 content;

5 grade for examinations, if any, required; and
6 (d) methods of monitoring compliance.
