DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 424 would require the Governor to develop a plan to present to the Legislature in 1981 indicating how state agencies could reduce central office administrative staff by 25%.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The plan would be prepared by the Office of Budget and Program Planning with information supplied by state agencies.
- 2. The preparation of the plan would require no additional staff, but would require some increased operational expenditures.
- 3. The preparation of the plan would take 18 months.
