- 1. Amend the title on line 5 after the word "PARDONS" by adding the following language: "AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE"
- 2. Add a new section after line 9, page 2, as follows: "Section 2. This act is effective upon passage and approval."
