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Jenate BILL NO. 449 INTRODUCED BY Molally 1 2 3 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE COUNTY 4 BOARD OF WELFARE'S AUTHORITY TO APPOINT A SUPERVISOR OF THE 5 COUNTY WELFARE DEPARTMENT; AMENDING SECTIONS 53-2-301 AND 6 53-2-304. MCA." 7 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9 Section 1. Section 53-2-301, MCA, is amended to read: 10 "53-2-301. County departments to be established. (1) 11 There shall be established in each county of the state a 12 county department of public welfare which shall consist of a 13 14 county board of public welfare and such staff personnel as may be necessary for the efficient performance of the public 15 assistance activities of the county. If conditions warrant 16 and if two or more county boards enter into an agreement, 17 two or more counties may combine into one administrative 18 unit and use the same staff personnel throughout the 19 administrative unit. 20 (2) The county board, with the approval of the 21 department of social and rehabilitation services. may 22 23 appoint some fully qualified person listed by the department

as director of its staff personnel, and the department may

exercise its powers under 53-2-203 to classify big as

director. If the county board does not approve the 2 appointment of a staff director, no staff personnel may be required to carry out the functions of a county director and 3 4 the department of social and rehabilitation services may not 5, exercise___its___powers___under__53-2-203__to__classify__any individual as director." . 7 Section 2. Section 53-2-304, MCA, is amended to read: #53-2-304. Staff personnel of county department. (1) A Each county board shall select and appoint from a list of 9 qualified persons furnished by the department of social and 10 11 rehabilitation services such staff personnel as are necessary. The staff personnel in each county shall consist 12 of at least one gualified staff worker (or investigator) and 13 14 such clerks and stenographers as may be decided necessary. 15 If--conditions--warranty-the-county-boardy-with-the-approval 16 of-the-deportment-of-social-and-rehabilitation-services, may 17 appoint-some-fully-gublified-person-listed-by-the-department as-supervisor-of-its-staff-personnel. The staff personnel of 18 19 each county department are directly responsible to the 20 county board, but the department of social and 21 rehabilitation services may supervise such county employees 22 in respect to the efficient and proper performance of their 23 duties. The county board of public welfare may not dismiss any member of the staff personnel without the approval of 24

25 the department of social and rehabilitation services, but

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the department may request the county board to dismiss any
 member of the staff personnel for inefficiency,
 incompetence, or similar cause.

4 (2) Public assistance staff personnel attached to the 5 county board shall be paid from state public assistance funds both their salaries and their travel expenses as 6 provided for in 2-18-501 through 2-18-503 when away from the 7 county seat in the performance of their duties, but the 8 9 county board of public welfare shall reimburse the 10 department of social and rehabilitation services from county 11 poor funds the full amount of the salaries and travel 12 expenses not reimbursed to the department by the federal 13 government and the full amount of the department's 14 administrative costs which are allocated by the department 15 to the county for the administration of county welfare 16 programs and not reimbursed to the department by the federal 17 government. Under circumstances prescribed by the department of social and rehabiliation services, the reimbursement by 18 19 the county board of public welfare may be less than the 20 county share as prescribed above. All other administrative 21 costs of the county department shall also be paid from 22 county poor funds.

(3) On or before the 20th day of the month following
the month for which the payments to the public assistance
staff personnel of the county were made, the department of

1 social and rehabilitation services shall present to the 2 county department of public welfare a claim for the required 3 reimbursements. The county board shall make such 4 reimbursements within 20 days after the presentation of the 5 claim, and the department of social and rehabilitation 6 services shall credit (add) all such reimbursements to its 7 account for administrative costs.⁴
