BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 50-60-301, MCA, is amended to read: *50-60-301. Municipal and county building codes 12 authorized. (1) The local legislative body of a municipality or county may adopt a building code by ordinance to apply to the municipal or county jurisdictional area. 14

(2) A municipal or county building code may include only codes adopted by the department, except that to further the purposes enumerated in subsections (5) and (6) of 50-60-201, a local governing body may adopt building regulations which require standards higher than those of the state building code."
