A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PRIORITIES TO ASSIGN A STUDY OF THE NEED FOR ANTITRUST LEGISLATION IN MONTANA AND, IF THERE IS A NEED, TO PROPOSE APPROPRIATE LEGISLATION.

WHEREAS, the "Montana Uniform Antitrust Act", Senate Bill 420, was introduced in the 46th Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature had insufficient information to determine the need for Senate Bill 420 and whether an alternative would be advisable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That the Committee on Priorities is requested to assign an Interim Committee to study the need for antitrust legislation in Montana and, if there is a need, the form such legislation should take, with special attention to Senate Bill 420 and the Uniform State Antitrust Act, as drafted by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the interim committee

1 report its findings and recommendations, together with any  
2 proposed legislation, to the 47th Legislature.
