 12 WHEREAS, hunting, fishing, and trapping are of great *Boyer*
 13 recreational and economic concern to the citizens of
 14 Montana; and
 15 WHEREAS, the vast distances between population centers
 16 in Montana requires that licenses be available in many
 17 locations for the convenience of the citizens of the state
 18 and the visitors to the state; and
 19 WHEREAS, it is the purpose and responsibility of the
 20 Department of Fish and Game to serve the people and to
 21 provide services to the citizens of the state in a manner
 22 designed for the convenience of the citizens rather than the
 23 convenience of the Department.

 2 That, within 60 days, the Department of Fish and Game
 3 is directed to promulgate a rule providing that 1-year
 4 conservation licenses may be purchased from any license
 5 agent.
 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that because of the proximity
 7 of the start of a new license year, the Department of Fish
 8 and Game is directed to adopt an emergency rule providing
 9 that 1-year conservation licenses may be purchased from any
 10 license agent and to adopt this emergency rule with an
 11 effective date prior to April 30, 1979.
