4 A RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA DIRECTING
5 THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS TO CONDUCT AN INTERIM STUDY TO
6 INVESTIGATE THE LACK OF CONSISTENCY IN WORK QUALITY AMONG
7 THE SEVERAL HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE SECTIONS OF THE STATE
8 DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS.

10 WHEREAS, good highways must be well maintained to be
11 safe for the motoring public; and

12 WHEREAS, routine highway maintenance functions are
13 performed and supervised in small organizational units known
14 as sections; and

15 WHEREAS, there is evidence that there is a wide
16 variance in the quality of routine maintenance work among
17 the several sections; and

18 WHEREAS, this condition indicates possible tax
19 management or other serious management problems that require
20 correction if public safety is to be served.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
23 MONTANA:

That the Department of Highways conduct an interim study to investigate the management problems of the

1 Maintenance Division of the Department of Highways and
2 report its findings and recommendations to the regular
3 session of the 47th Legislature.
