24	(c) a brief summary of any arguments opposed to or in
25	favor of suspension;

- 1 (d) the date by which legislators must return the 2 ballot, which may not be more than 30 days after the date of 3 the mailing of the ballots; and
- (e) a stamped return envelope.
- 5 (2) The committee shall keep the ballots secret until 6 all legislators have voted or until the day after the data 7 set for return of the ballots, whichever occurs first.
- 3 (3) If a majority of the legislators reply 9 affirmatively to the poll, the committee shall notify each 10 legislator and the agency of the results of the poll. If a 11 majority reply affirmatively, the rule is suspended 12 effective upon notification of the agency and until the end 13 of the 30th day of the next regular session of the legislature. 14
- (4) If a majority of the legislators fail to approve 15 the suspension of the rule within 30 days after the 1 ò 17 committee mails the ballots, all ballots are void and may 18 not be used again. The entire process must be regeated to 19 suspend an agency rule.
- 20 Section 2. Submission to electorate. this 21 emendment is submitted to the qualified electors of Montana, 22 there shall be printed on the ballot the full title of this 23 act and the following words:
