BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Notification of death. Any hospital or health care facility where a death occurs or any county coroner or state medical examiner having possession of or jurisdiction over a body shall make every attempt, within 2 days after the occurrence of death is known; to contact the next of kin of the deceased or any other responsible party to determine the preferred final disposition of the deceased before releasing the remains to a person in charge of interment. If the place of death or coroner having jurisdiction does not have suitable facilities for storage of the deceased pending notification of next of kin or other responsible party, storage may be arranged at a convenient interment facility. The local registrar may not issue a permit for final disposition of the deceased until the notification period has ended.
