(2) The fire marshal shall issue a license to an applicant who submits satisfactory proof that he is properly equipped and staffed to provide the services to be licensed and who pays the required fee.

- (3) The fire marshal shall issue a certificate of registration to an applicant who scores a passing grade on an examination devised by the fire marshal and who pays the required fee.
- 24 (4) The fire marshal shall issue a sales permit to an25 applicant who submits the information required by the fire

marshal on the application form, who submits satisfactory proof that he deals only in equipment that meets the standards and regulations of the state fire marshal, and who pays the required fee. (5) Each license or certificate of registration must be renewed each year. No examination may be required for 7 renewal." Section 2. Section 50-39-105, MCA, is amended to read: "50-39-105. Fees.
