 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE ANNUAL
 6 RENEWAL OF LICENSES AND CERTIFICATES OF PERSONS WHO INSTALL
 7 OR SERVICE FIRE PROTECTION EQUIPMENT; AMENDING SECTIONS
 8 50-39-102 AND 50-39-105, MCA."

 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 50-39-102, MCA, is amended to read:
 12 "50-39-102. Application for certificate, permit, and
 13 license. (1) Applications for licenses, permits, or
 14 certificates shall be made on a form prescribed by the state
 15 fire marshal.

16 (2) The fire marshal shall issue a license to an
 17 applicant who submits satisfactory proof that he is properly
 18 equipped and staffed to provide the services to be licensed
 19 and who pays the required fee.

20 (3) The fire marshal shall issue a certificate of
 21 registration to an applicant who scores a passing grade on
 22 an examination devised by the fire marshal and who pays the
 23 required fee.

24 (4) The fire marshal shall issue a sales permit to an
 25 applicant who submits the information required by the fire

1 marshal on the application form, who submits satisfactory
 2 proof that he deals only in equipment that meets the
 3 standards and regulations of the state fire marshal, and who
 4 pays the required fee.

5 ~~(5) Each license or certificate of registration must~~
 6 ~~be renewed each year. No examination may be required for~~
 7 ~~renewal."~~

8 Section 2. Section 50-39-105, MCA, is amended to read:
 9 "50-39-105. Fees. (1) The state fire marshal or his
 10 representative shall charge a fee, not to exceed a total of
 11 \$25, for the inspection, end issuance, and renewal of
 12 licenses, permits, and certificates.

13 (2) All fees collected under this section shall be
 14 paid into the general fund."
