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17 (1) he has registered for work at and thereafter has continued to report at an employment office in accordance 13 19 with such regulation as the division may prescribe, except that the division may, by regulation, prescribe that in 20 cases in which it finds such requirements oppressive or 21 22 inconsistent with the purposes of this chapter, an 23 unemployed individual may register and report for work by 24 .rail or through other governmental agencies;

if the division finds that:

25 (2) he has made a claim for benefits in accordance

2 (3) he is able to work and is available for work and 3 is seeking work; provided, however, that no claimant is considered insligible in any week of unemployment for 4 5 failure to comply with the provisions of this subsection if such failure is due to an illness or disability which occurs ó 7 after he has registered for work and no suitable work has 8 been offered to such claimant after the beginning of such 9 illness or disability;

10 (4) prior to any week for which he claims benefits he has been totally unemployed for a waiting period of 1 week. 11 12 However, if claimant's benefit year expires during a period 13 of compensable unemployment, claimant will continue to receive weekly benefits in a new benefit year, if otherwise 14 15 eligible, without interruption to serve the waiting week for the new benefit year but will thereafter be required to 16 serve the waiting week before receiving benefits during 17 18 subsequent unemployment in the new benefit year. No week is 19 counted as a week of total unemployment for the purposes of 20 this subsection:

(a) if benefits have been paid with respect thereto;
(b) unless the individual was aligible for benefits
with respect thereto;
