9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 7-33-2209, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "7-33-2209. Finance of fire control activities. (1) The
12 county governing body is authorized to appropriate funds for
13 the purchase, care, and maintenance of firefighting
14 equipment or for the payment of wages in prevention,
15 detection, and suppression of fires.

16 (2) If the general fund is budgeted to the full limit,
17 the county governing body may, at any time fixed by law for
18 levy and assessment of taxes, levy a tax at such rate as in
19 their judgment will be necessary to raise such needed sum,
20 not to exceed ~~\$15,000~~ \$40,000."

13 the purchase, care, and maintenance of firefighting
14 equipment or for the payment of wages in prevention,
15 detection, and suppression of fires.
