BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$124,095 from the general fund to the Montana state school for the deaf and blind for the biennium ending June 30, 1981, for the purpose of providing supplemental funding for the interpretive-tutor program.

Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
