Be it enacted by the legislature of the state of montana:
Section l. Section 39-51-1103, ACA, is amended to
read:
"39-51-1103. Contributions by employers required --
payments in lieu thereof authorized for certain employers.
(1) Contributions shall accrue and become payable by each
employer for each calendar year in which he is subject to
this chapter with respect to wages, as defined in
3s-51-201(19), paid for employment, as defined in this
cïspter, occurring during such calendar year.
(2) Such contributions shall become due and be paid by
Each employer to the division for the fund in accordance
with such regulations as the division may prescribe and
shall not be deducted in whole or in part from the wages of
individuals in fris employ.
(3) In the payment of any contributions, a fractional
part of a cent shall be disregarded unless it amounts to
one-nalf cent or more, in which case it shall be increased to 1 cent.
(4) Nonprofit organizations defined in section 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal Revenue Code and which are exempt from tax under section $501(a)$ of such code may elect to wake payments in 1 ie of contributions.
(इ) The state and its political subdivisions, effective January 1, 1977, may elect to make payments in lieu of contributions or pay under a special contributions plan established for governmental entities only.
