4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING COOPERATIVES,
5 AS DEFINED IN TITLE 35, CHAPTER 18, MCA, TO MAKE PAYMENTS IN
6 LIEU OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE STATE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE
7 FUND; AMENDING SECTION 39-51-1103, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 39-51-1103, MCA, is amended to
11 read:

12 "39-51-1103. Contributions by employers required --
13 payments in lieu thereof authorized for certain employers.

14 (1) Contributions shall accrue and become payable by each
15 employer for each calendar year in which he is subject to
16 this chapter with respect to wages, as defined in
17 39-51-201(19), paid for employment, as defined in this
18 chapter, occurring during such calendar year.

19 (2) Such contributions shall become due and be paid by
20 each employer to the division for the fund in accordance
21 with such regulations as the division may prescribe and
22 shall not be deducted in whole or in part from the wages of
23 individuals in his employ.

24 (3) In the payment of any contributions, a fractional
25 part of a cent shall be disregarded unless it amounts to

1 one-half cent or more, in which case it shall be increased
2 to 1 cent.

3 (4) Nonprofit organizations defined in section
4 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal Revenue Code and which are
5 exempt from tax under section 501(a) of such code may elect
6 to make payments in lieu of contributions.

7 (5) The state and its political subdivisions,
8 effective January 1, 1977, may elect to make payments in
9 lieu of contributions or pay under a special contributions
10 plan established for governmental entities only.

11 ~~(6) Cooperatives as defined in Title 35, chapter 18,~~
12 ~~may elect to make payments in lieu of contributions."~~
