4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO MAKE BINGO PRIZE AND
5 CARD PRICE RESTRICTIONS NONAPPLICABLE TO NONPROFIT
6 CORPORATIONS, RELIGIOUS CORPORATIONS SOLE, AND OTHER
7 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS WHEN THE PROCEEDS OF THE BINGO GAMES
8 ARE USED FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Exemption from restrictions -- bingo. (1)
12 The restrictions of 23-5-412 do not apply to bingo games
13 conducted by nonprofit corporations, religious corporations
14 sole, or other nonprofit organizations if the proceeds are
15 used only for charitable purposes or to pay for prizes.

16 (2) The charitable purpose for which the bingo is
17 being conducted must be posted in a conspicuous place in the
18 area where and at all times when the game is in progress, in
19 letters readable from 10 feet away.

20 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
21 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 23,
22 chapter 5, part 4, and the provisions of Title 15, chapter
23 5, part 4, apply to section 1.
