A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING THAT
EMPLOYEE VACATION LEAVE AND VACATION PAY MUST BE CREDITED
OVER THE ENTIRE PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT, IF AT ALL."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Accrual of vacation benefits. (1) If
vacation leave or vacation pay for the employee are terms of
an employment agreement, such benefits accrue and must be
credited over the entire period of employment. If the
employee is terminated all vacation time that accrued to
that date shall be paid, except as provided otherwise in
2-18-617 for employees covered under that section.

(2) This section does not require that vacation
benefits be offered as a term of employment.
