In compliance with a written request received <u>January 12</u>, 19 <u>81</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 149</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

House Bill No. 149 increases the entitlement for reimbursement of legislators' in session expenses from \$40 to \$45 a day. The act would apply to all days since January 4, 1981.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Legislature:

Current law expense allowance cost: \$630,000 Proposes law expense allowance cost: \$708,750 Increase cost to general fund \$78,750

These figures apply to both FY 81 and 83 COMMENT:

The above information assumes that the Legislature will meet for 90 days in regular session six days each week. Thus, there will be 15 extra days of expenses for a total of 105 days in the session.
