4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO DESIGNATE STATE AND  
5 NATIONAL ELECTION DAYS AS SCHOOL HOLIDAYS; AMENDING SECTION  
6 20-1-305, MCA."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 20-1-305, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "20-1-305. School holidays. (1) Pupil instruction and  
11 pupil-instruction-related days shall not be conducted on the  
12 following holidays:

- 13 (a) New Year's Day (January 1);
- 14 (b) Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
- 15 (c) Independence Day (July 4);
- 16 (d) Labor Day (first Monday in September);
- 17 (e) Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
- 18 (f) Christmas Day (December 25);
- 19 (g) State and national election days ~~when--the--school~~

20 ~~building--is--used--as--a--polling--place--and--the--conduct--of~~  
21 ~~school--would--interfere--with--the--election--process--at--the~~  
22 ~~polling--place.~~

23 (2) When these holidays fall on Saturday or Sunday,  
24 the preceding Friday or the succeeding Monday shall not be a  
25 school holiday."
