9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 39-3-704, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "39-3-704. Exception. The provisions of this part do

12 not apply to any resident contractor who presents to the

13 commissioner a financial statement certified by a licensed

14 certified public accountant attesting to a net worth of the

15 contractor in excess of \$50,000 \$200,000."
