11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Required brucellosis vaccination. (1) No
13 female cattle over the age of 12 months may be imported into
14 the state of Montana for any purpose other than immediate
15 slaughter unless they have been officially vaccinated, by a
16 licensed veterinarian approved in his state to administer
17 the vaccination, with a *Brucella abortus* vaccine approved by
18 the veterinary biologics division, U.S. department of
19 agriculture.

(2) Cattle being transported or moved through Montana with no intent to unload in the state are exempt from [this act]. In an emergency situation they may be unloaded in compliance with quarantine rules promulgated by the department of livestock pursuant to 81-2-102.

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

Description of Proposed Legislation

House Bill 247 requires all cattle over 12 months old that are imported into Montana to be vaccinated for brucellosis.

Fiscal Impact

House Bill 247 will have no fiscal impact on the Department of Livestock. The vaccination history of the cattle can be included on the official health certificate.
