BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 16-3-304, MCA, is amended to read: "16-3-304. Closing hours for licensed retail establishments. licensed establishments A11 wherein alcoholic beverages are sold, offered for sale, or given away at retail shall be closed each day during mountain standard time between 2 a.m. and 8 a.m. and during daylight savings time between 3 a.m. and 8 a.m.; provided, however, that when any municipal incorporation has by ordinance further restricted the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages, then the sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited within the limits of any such city or town during the time such sale is prohibited by this code and in addition thereto during the hours that it is prohibited by such ordinance. During such hours all persons except the owner and employees of such licensed establishments shall be excluded therefrom except as provided in 16-3-305.**
