SE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Application of teacher tenure law to collective bargaining. (1) Sections 20-4-203 through 20-4-206 do not apply to any school district or its trustees or teachers when the trustees have entered into a valid collective bargaining agreement with the teachers of the district.

- (2) Consecutive employment contracts for nontenure teachers resulting from a collective bargaining agreement are not counted for purposes of teacher tenure.
- (3) For the purposes of this section, a "consecutive employment contract" is a contract resulting from reelection or automatic reelection pursuant to 20-4-206(1).
- (4) The provisions of subsections (1) and (2) apply to any school district and its trustees and teachers 90 days from the expiration of any current collective bargaining

- agreement between such trustees and teachers.
- Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is
