4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
5 50-6C-301, MCA, TO PERMIT A LOCAL GOVERNING BODY TO ADOPT  
6 BUILDING REGULATIONS REQUIRING STRICTER INSULATION STANDARDS  
7 THAN THOSE OF THE STATE BUILDING CODE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10           Section 1. Section 50-60-301, MCA, is amended to read:

11           \*50-60-301. Municipal and county building codes

12           authorized. (1) The local legislative body of a municipality

13           or county may adopt a building code by ordinance to apply to

14           the municipal or county jurisdictional area.

15 (2) A municipal or county building code may include  
16 only codes adopted by the department except that a local  
17 governing body may adopt building regulations requiring  
18 stricter insulation standards than those of the state code  
19 to further the purposes of subsections 151 and 161 of  
20 50-60-201."
