35 IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 10 11 Section 1. Section 61-3-101, MCA, is amended to read: 12 "61-3-101. Duties of division of motor vehicles ---13 records. (1) The division of motor vehicles shall keep a 14 record as hereinafter specified of all motor vehicles. 15 trailers, and semitrailers of every kind, and of cartificates of registration and ownership thereof, and of 16 all dealers in motor vehicles. 17

1d (2) In the case of motor vehicles, trailers, and19 semitrailers, the record shall show the followinc:

20 (a) name of owner, residence by town and county, and
21 business adgress;

(b) name and address of conditional sales vendor,
mortgagee, or other lienholder and amount due under contract
or lien;

25 (c) manufacturer of car;

(d) manufacturer's designation of style of car or vehicle;
(e) identifying number;
(f) year of manufacture;
(g) character of motive power and shipping weight of car as shown by the manufacturer;
(h) the distinctive license number assigned to the vehicle;

(c) numerically under make and identifying number ofthe vehicle;
