BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 25-7-224, MCA, is amended to read:

"25-7-224. Peremptory challenges to jurors. (1) Each
party is entitled to four six peremptory challenges, except
as provided for under subsection (2). If no peremptory
challenges are taken until the panel is full, they must be
taken by the parties alternately, commencing with the
plaintiff.

(2) Where a six-person jury is authorized by law, each side shall have two three peremptory challenges. They shall be exercised by the plaintiff first striking one and the defendant then striking one, and so on until each side has exhausted or waived his rights.**
