NEW SECTION. Section 1. Regulation of cable TV. The public service commission has full power of supervision, regulation, and control of community antenna systems, commonly referred to as cable TV. The provisions of Title 69, chapter 3, apply to the supervision, regulation, and control of community antenna systems, and references to public utilities in Title 69, chapter 3, include community antenna systems.

Section 2. Section 69-3-101, MCA, is amended to read:

"69-3-101. Meaning of term public utility. (11 The

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to include cable television systems as a public utility.

- 3. To insure that construction, extension, and operation of Cable TV companies is provided as a public convenience a complete staff analysis must include engineering data from a communications engineer and a rate analyst.
