1 INTRODUCED BY Kincen 2 3 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SERVICES 5 TO CERTIFIABLY HANDICAPPED STUDENTS ENROLLED IN UNITS OF THE 5 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM: AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THIS PROGRAM." 7 8 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: Section 1. Short title. [This act] may be cited as the 10 11 *University System Handicapped Student Services Funding Act 12 of 1981". 13 Section 2. Purpose. [This act] is intended to provide 14 needed services to certifiably handicapped students enrolled 15 in units of the university system. Such services may include specialized educational material and equipment, support and 16 17 referral services, academic support. specialized 18 recreational equipment, therapy, career and placement services, and the personnel to implement these services. 19 Funds appropriated for the purposes of [this act] may not be 23 21 used for the purposes of campus or classroom accessibility 22 for handicapped students. 23 Section 3. Definition. As used in [this act]. 24 "certifiably handicapped student" means a student who 25 possesses a limitation that is certified as such by a

audiclogist, speech licensed physician, psychologist, pathologist, registered nurse, social worker, rehabilitation counselor, physical therapist, or other appropriate professional. Section 4. Casis for distribution of funds. (1) The commissioner of higher education shall: (a) establish guidelines for certifying handicapped students: (b) determine the number of certifiably handicapped students at each unit of the university system; (c) estimate an average amount of appropriation due for each certifiably handicapped student enrolled in each unit of the university system; and (d) insure an equitable distribution of the appropriated funds to each unit of the university system based on the average amount due for each certifiably handicapped student. (2) The office of budget and program planning shall

Section 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the office of budget and program planning the sum of \$834,953 from the general fund for the biennium ending June 30, 1983, for the purposes of disbursing such funds to the

Description of Proposed Legislation:

H. B. 319 provides for services to certifiably handicapped students enrolled in units of the Montana University System. This bill appropriates \$447,971 for FY 82 and \$386,987 for FY 83.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. First year cost per student would be \$920 and second year costs per student would be \$795.
- 2. There are estimated to be 487 certifiably handicapped students.
