HOUSE BILL NO. 328

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO SUBMIT TO THE
QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III,
SECTION 6, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO PROVIDE THAT THE
LEGISLATURE MAY LIMIT THE NUMBER OF INITIATIVES WHICH MAY
APPEAR ON THE BALLOT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR
THE AMENDMENT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Article III, section 6, of the Constitution
of the State of Montana, is amended to read:

"Section 6. Elections. The people shall vote on initiative and referendum measures at the general election unless the legislature orders a special election. The legislature may limit the number of initiative measures that may be included on the ballot at a general or special election."

Section 2. Effective date. If approved by the electorate, this amendment shall be effective January 1, 1983.

Section 3. Submission to electorate. This amendment shall be submitted to the electors of the state of Montana at the general election to be held November 2, 1982, by

1 printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the
2 following:

3 FCP allowing the legislature to limit the number of
4 initiatives that may appear on the ballot.

5 AGAINST allowing the legislature to limit the number
6 of initiatives that may appear on the ballot.
