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10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Extended benefits filed interstate. Except
12 during the first 2 weeks of an extended benefit period, no
13 extended benefits will be paid to an individual filing from
14 a state in which the state indicator is "off".
