BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-1-308, MCA, is amended to read:
#20-1-308. Religious instruction released time
program. (1) The trustees of an elementary or high school
district may provide for a religious instruction released
time program under which a pupil may be released from
regular school attendance for a period-not-to-exceed-2-hours
per--week for the purpose of receiving religious instruction
upon written request, renewed at least annually, of the
pupil's parent or guardian. Religious instruction released
time may not exceed 2 hours in any week for pupils of an
elementary district and 5 hours in any week for pupils of a
high school district.

- (2) No religious instruction released time program may be established or administered in such a way that public school property is utilized for the purpose of religious instruction.
- (3) No public moneys may be used, directly or

indirectly, for such religious instruction.

2 (4) Any period for which a pupil is released under a
3 religious instruction released time program is part of the
4 school day and week for purposes of 20-1-301, 20-1-302,
5 20-5-103, 20-9-311, and all other provisions of Title 20,
6 and such release may not adversely affect the pupil's
7 attendance record.**
