16	(2) Initiative petitions must contain the full text of
17	the proposed measure, shall be signed by at least five
18	percent of the qualified electors in each of at least
19	one-third of the legislative representative districts and
20	the total number of signers must be at least five percent of
21	the total qualified electors of the state. Petitions shall
2 2	be filed with the secretary of state at least three months
23	prior to the election at which the measure will be voted
24	upon.

(3) The sufficiency of the initiative petition shall

not be questioned after the election is held. 1 2 [4] A law enacted by initiative is fully effective unless amended or repealed by a two-thirds wote of each 3 house of the legislature." 4 5 Section 2. If approved by the electorate, this 6 amendment shall be effective immediately on such approval. Section 3. Submission to electorate. This amendment 7 8 shall be submitted to the electors of the state of Montana 9 at the general election held November 2, 1982, by printing 10 on the ballot the full title of this act and the following 11 words: 12 FOR requiring a two-thirds vote of each house of the 13 legislature to amend or repeal a law enacted by initiative. 14 15 AGAINST requiring a two-thirds vote of each house of the legislature to amend or repeal a law enacted by 16
