(5) A record of permission granted shall be kept by the 2 3 clerk of the court. The record shall state the date of the application, the date of the permission, the name of the 4 5 person to whom permission is granted, the name of the judge 6 granting the permission, and the name of the person, if any, 7 by whom good moral character and peaceable disposition are 8 proved. The record must be signed by the person who is 9 granted such permission.

### FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request received <u>JANAURY 23</u>, 19 <u>81</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>HOUSE BILL 359</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 359 is an act setting a fee of \$25.00 for an application for permission to carry a concealed weapon.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

Average number of applications for permits in future years is approximately the same as the average number in the past.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

1.8

Based on the estimated number of applications for permits in the state per year the District Clerk of Court would collect approximately \$18,000 to \$20,000 per year. There would not be an increase in costs for the collection of this fee since the application procedure already exists in the Clerk's office. Based on the figures above and current law the state would receive approximately \$10,800 to \$12,000 more per year in revenue; and the county would receive approximately \$7,200 to \$8,000 more per year in revenue.

# TECHNICAL NOTES:

This bill (HB 359) would possibly be in conflict with another proposed bill (SB 121). Senate Bill 121 changes the fee schedules for Clerks of District Court and includes a new fee for gun permits issued which is \$5.00.
