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HOUSE BILL NO. 373

INTRODUCED BY Kemma Thomas Bertelsen: Stelchen

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BY REQUEST OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL

5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CREATING THE POSITION

6 OF PERMIT FACILITATOR IN THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND SETTING

7 FORTH THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Office of permit facilitator. (1) The governor shall create within his office the position of permit facilitator. The position shall be filled by appointment by the governor.

- (2) The permit facilitator serves at the pleasure of the governor.
- (3) The governor shall select the permit facilitator on the basis of his professional and administrative knowledge and experience.

Section 2. Permit information center. (1) The permit facilitator shall establish a permit requirements information center in Helena, Montana, for the purpose of providing, maintaining, revising, and updating information pertaining to the licenses and permits required by state agencies before various commercial or industrial projects or activities proposed in the state can be initiated.

(2) The permit facilitator shall encourage and invite federal and local government agencies to make license and permit information available to applicants through the information center. The permit facilitator shall, so far as is practicable, advise applicants of federal and local government agency license and permit requirements.

7 Section 3. Agency reports. (1) Before October 1, 1981, 8 each state agency with authority to review, approve, or grant licenses or permits for commercial or industrial 10 projects or activities shall report to the permit facilitator concerning such authority. Application forms, 11 applicable agency rules, and the estimated time period 12 13 necessary for consideration of a license or permit application based on experience and statutory or regulatory 14 15 requirements shall accompany each state agency report.

(2) Each state agency shall report to the permit facilitator any new license or permit or modification of an existing license or permit that becomes effective as a requirement subsequent to the report submitted pursuant to subsection (1), together with applicable forms, rules, and information.

22 Section 4. Assistance to applicants. Upon the request 23 of an applicant for a commercial or industrial license or 24 permit, the permit facilitator shall provide reasonable 25 assistance to the applicant in the identification and LC 0133/01

1 processing of licenses and permits required for the

2 applicant's project.
